WELCOME EVERYONE TO A NEW SCHOOL YEAR AND A SPECIAL WELCOME TO OUR NEW STARTERS! WE ARE DELIGHTED TO HAVE YOU JOIN OUR SCHOOL FAMILY HERE AT SHPS.

We are very pleased to be back and all pupils and teachers have settled very well into their new classes. The atmosphere in school is very focused on learning and behaviour in all classes and on the yard is excellent. We hope this is a sign of good things to come. We welcome Ms Hardy class 6 and Ms Hanson class 3 to our team, also our new sports apprentice Ms Smith.

This year teachers in classes will be in charge of rewards and sanctions for behaviour and only the more serious cases will be handed over to the senior management team. If you wish to discuss your child's behaviour please contact their class teacher through the main office. We will contact you if there are issues. **KEEPING US UP TO SPEED**: Please make sure we have current mobile phone numbers and addresses for your child. In an emergency we will follow the list of contacts in the order you have given us so please also make sure these are up to date. **UNIFORM:** I am thrilled at the way parents support our uniform policy and must say how wonderful all children look in their new uniforms. Please make sure names are inside all clothes and this makes it easy for us to return them to their owners. Remember black shoes only and no coloured trainers. If a pupil does not have our uniform on we will send a text to parents to remind them of our expectations.
