EARINGS FOR PE LESSONS: It is school policy agreed by the governing body that all pupils remove or tape earings for PE lessons. This is in line with county advice and follows the 'Safe Practice in Physical Education and School Sport' guidance. Your child must be able to remove their own earings or cover them with tape provided by yourself (we recommend small plasters or medical tape put into the PE bag). You could remove your child's earings on PE day before coming to school. SAFC coaches and CNS coaches will not permit pupils wearing earings to participate in competitions and festivals. PE is a statutory part of the National Curriculum. DRINKS AT LUCHTIME: We provide fresh water and cool milk at the expense of the school for all pupils at lunchtime and they can drink as much as they like. Please do not send drinks in packed lunch boxes as it is unfair that packed lunch pupils have special drinks and hot meals pupils do not. Thank you for your understanding in the matter.

PHOTOGRAPHS: The deadline for monies in for photographs to be purchased from Tempest is this Monday 28.11.16. to receive the photos in time for Christmas. Sadly we are unable to provide extended family photos because of the time Tempest can spend in school and the logistics of managing this number of visitors to school and keep our pupils safe and maximise learning time.
