HOMEWORK- Homework is an important part of school life and we expect pupils to complete the small amount they are given each week. This prepares them well for secondary school and encourages them to develop independence in learning. Some pupils are coming into school saying they have done it but left it at home. Please encourage your child to do their own homework ( it is always consolidation of learning done in school) and put it into their bag straight away to bring back to school.

**READING-** Please make sure your child is reading to you or under your supervision at least three times each week and sign their diary. Reading is the key to all other learning and we need pupils to be fluent and expressive readers able to talk about texts and investigate them. The last years SATS reading test was very challenging and we are focusing on pupils reading at speed to gather information quickly. Thank you for your help with this. Please make sure your child puts their reading record in their bag to bring into school.

**PUPIL COLLECTION:** School finished at 3.15pm and this is the time pupils must be collected from school. If they are going to after school clubs they must be booked in a week in advance and paid for.

**DINNER MONEY:** is due in each Monday. Please instruct your child to put it into the class box or come to pay it at Reception. We remind pupils not to leave money in bags in the cloakrooms.
