Christmas fair

Collection of children

EYFS and Key Stage one children must be collected from their classes by an adult unless they are attending after school club. Under no circumstances will we allow an EYFS or Key Stage 1 child to make their own way home. From Year 3, children are able to go home alone, however if you would prefer us to formally hand over your child and not allow them to meet you at a prearranged place or make their own way home we are very happy to do this. Please speak to your child's class teacher to make this arrangement.
