Breakfast club doors will open only 5 minutes before any events held in the main hall to allow visitors into school. This is for safeguarding reasons so please do not queue up too early. After events pupils will not be released early. They will be taken back to class and dismissed from their usual entrances at 3.15 pm. You are welcome to wait in the hall if weather is poor. This ensures all pupils are accounted for in line with safeguarding procedures.

MOVING UP DAY- We have carefully planned our pupil placements for September and have worked together with the local authority to ensure all pupils are well placed to achieve their very best in the coming year. On FRIDAY 30th June your child will spend the morning in the classroom with the teacher for next year. They will engage in fun activities for the morning and return to their current classes for the afternoon. Some children will not be moving rooms but the year group will change, this is to allow for our mixed age classes right across the school which will start from class 1 and 2 after pre school. There will be no Rainbow, Sunshine classes as they will teach an EYFS and Y1 curriculum. Sparkle will become pre school and will teach an EYFS curriculum. It is a statutory requirement that all pupils are taught the appropriate curriculum for their age so all teachers are skilled in delivering across at least two years. We hope your child will make new friends as they change classes as we plan for the classes to work closely together and children will have opportunities to see each other at many events throughout the school day. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD COMES TO SCHOOL ON THIS DAY AS IT IS IMPORTANT FOR THEM TO MOVE CLASSES TOGETHER.
