CASHLESS SCHOOL: From 1st September 2019, we will become a cashless school. All payments for trips, dinners, before and after school clubs can all be paid online using our Parentpay system. If you need your user name/password please contact the office. If possible please ensure your account is active prior to the summer holidays so that you are ready for the new school year.

PARENTPAY: Well done to 74% of parents who have activated their Parentpay account! We still have 88 parents who need to do it, if you require assistance please contact the office.

LUNCHTIME ARRANGEMENTS: Please contact the office to give 2 weeks notice if your child wishes to swap to school meals or packed lunch. Our kitchen staff requires dinner numbers 2 weeks in advance to ensure that the correct amount of ingredients have been ordered.

PLAYGROUND: We are about to start to develop the yard areas to make them more suitable for use, for outdoor learning and PE/Sports. You will see some lovely changes in the coming months.

WARM WEATHER: Please ensure your child has sun cream applied before coming into school each morning and provide your child with a sun hat/cap and water bottle to keep them shaded and hydrated during the school day. Please be aware staff are not permitted to put cream on pupils and pupils are not allowed to share others cream for safety.

NATIONAL SCHOOL BREAKFAST PROGRAMME: Our bagel initiative is working extremely well with no child in our school starting the day hungry. Some pupils even like to come for extras! The children collect their magic bagel as part of their routine each morning when putting away their lunch boxes, hanging their coats and sorting out their reading books. We are finding that pupils work much better up to lunchtime than before. Well done everyone!
