



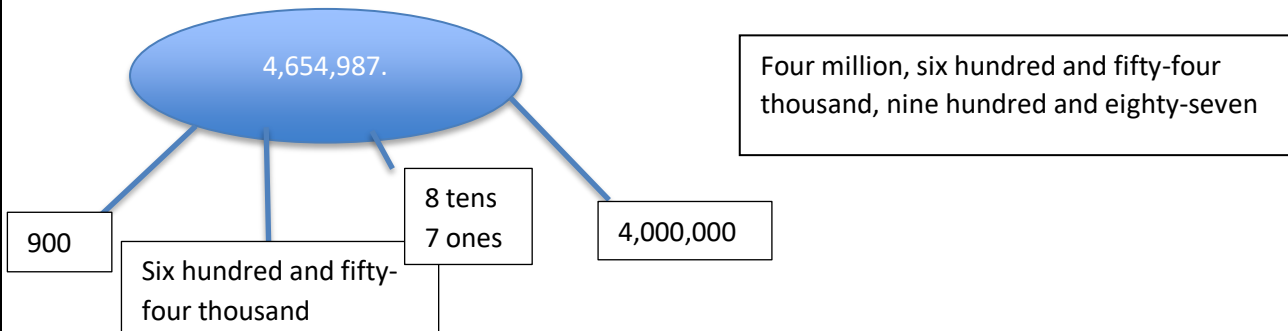
Maths – answers (20.4.20)

- **Simple** – because the conjunction (and) used is for a compound noun (Miss Hardy and Mrs. Hext) not to separate two main clauses.
 - **Complex** – because it is made up of an independent clause: 'Miss Hardy and Mrs. Hext have been ordering their shopping online' and a dependent clause 'Because we must stay at home as much as we can' linked together by the subordinating conjunction, 'because'.
 - **Compound** – because it's made up of two simple sentences that are connected by the coordinating conjunction, 'and'.
