The document asks you to make a list of foods from plants and identify which parts can be eaten, for example stem, root, fruit. After reading the information, design your own meal (for example a salad or a stir-fry) and identify the parts of plants you have used. Perhaps sometime this week you could help make some food, like a stir-fry, and identify the parts of plants to be eaten.
