Sing our 'Days of the week song' as in last week's link:



Challenge!

* Ask a grown up to draw a simple large feather shape on some A4



paper or card, cut it out, then draw 1 line up the centre plus the lines across **both** halves of it. It should start to look a little like the second picture...

* Your turn! Practise your 'careful cutting' to snip slowly along the lines to nearly at the centre. Remember not to cut all the way across the centre of the feather or it will break into 2 pieces.

'Careful cutting' can be tricky at first and takes lots of practise to cut on the lines. Try saying "Open and snip" as you cut, as we would in class. Maybe try a second feather? I would love you to share and to see how your cutting looks?
