Challenge!

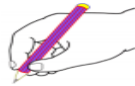
Musical Numbers

You will need:

- 10 bits of paper
- A pen
- Something to play music on

To set up:

1. On each piece of paper, write a different number 1 to 10. Remember your 'Froggy Fingers'



2. Spread the numbers about on the floor.



3. Put the music on standby.

To play:

1. When the music plays, dance or move around between the numbers. Then, when the music stops, step onto a number and shout it out. Grownup to jump on a number too, and shout it out.
2. Remove the numbers that get jumped on, and start the music again.
3. Keep going until there is only one number left to win, or until all the numbers are gone.
