Maths – answers – 22.5.20

1. 45 r2
2. Incorrect – The correct answer should be 229 r3. $108 = 9 \times 12$ and not 8×12 .
3. Long division. Answer: 166 boxes are needed for all packets of biscuits (165 r3)
4. Long division. Answer: 121 full packets (121 r10 – the remainder of 10 would not make a full packet)
5. Long multiplication. Answer: 3690 minutes
6. Long multiplication. Answer: £202.23 (it's really important that you acknowledged that we were dealing with money in this question)
