4. Felt tips are sold in packs of 12. How many full packets can be made with 1462 felt tips?
5. It takes 18 minutes to make a toy car. How many minutes will it take to make 205 cars?
6. There are 27 children in a class. Each child pay £7.49 for a school trip. How much is paid altogether?

**Challenge (optional):** create your own long multiplication/division word problem for a family member to solve. It's your turn to be the teacher! See if you can teach them the method we use in school - you might use your revision guide to help you do this!
