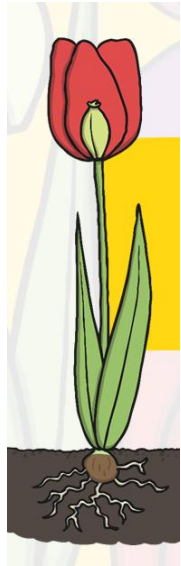

seed

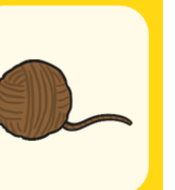
Or
