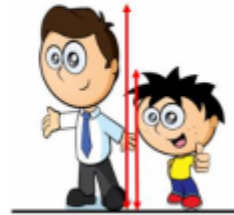
Compare lengths and heights

Use the words **taller** and **shorter** in the sentence stems to compare the height of the man and the boy.

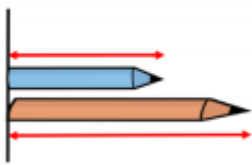
The man is than the boy.

How many different sentences can you make to compare the vehicles? Say them to an adult.

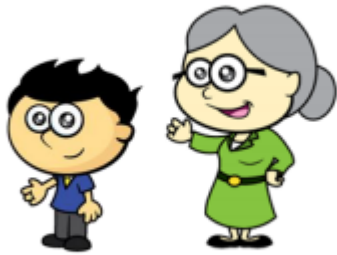

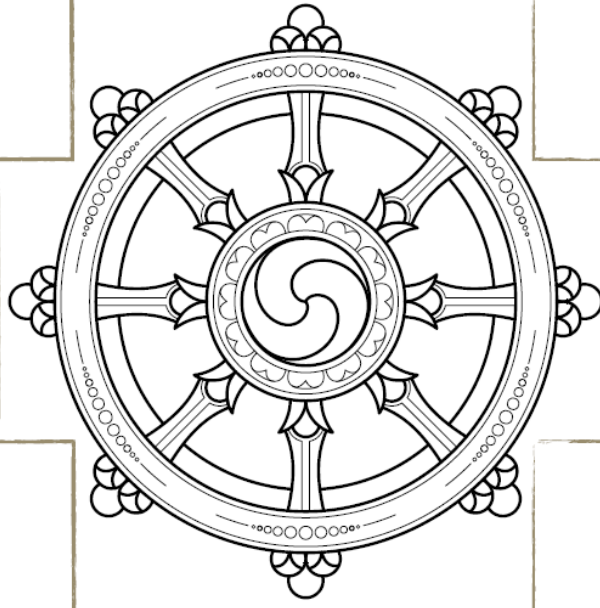
Who was Buddha?
