Maths

Topic work - Art

Choose lots of things from your own life to draw in the house and the garden.

Draw things carefully from your memory making some things look realistic, but also try making some things seem smaller or bigger than they really are. You can use any colouring materials you like (crayons, pencils, pens, paints).

Your finished picture should tell people something about you.
