Maths

Draw the setting for the poem. Where is the sound collector? What is around him? Include in your picture at least eight things that can be heard in the poem. Label the objects (nouns) and the sound they are making (verb) in your picture. For example – squeaking chair, ticking clock.

Topic work – Growing

Read the information about seeds and bulbs. Then complete the activity by matching the plant to the right bulb or seed. If you do not want to print the sheet, you could draw and label the matching seeds and plants to make your own fact file.

As an extra challenge, you could complete some research to discover which other plants grow from bulbs. What is the biggest seed in the world?
