Maths

Today's work is about counting and remembering the number of edges that different 3D shapes have. **An edge is where two flat faces meet, or where a flat face meets a curved surface.** It would be helpful if you could use the real examples of these shapes that you have found around your home, so you can count the edges accurately.

English

This sheet has different activities for practising correct use of spelling, punctuation and grammar. Just write your answers on paper, and then check the answer sheet on Friday.

I have also included a list of spellings that you could practise this week. They are common exception words, which means they are words we use often but you don't spell them the way they sound so they need to be learned. Can you write each word in a sentence? You can also use this opportunity to practise your neat, cursive handwriting.

Topic work – Art

Today we are making a 3D art sculpture in the style of Miro. This may take more than one day to complete, especially if you are painting your sculpture (but you can just use pens or pencils if you like). We will be using card to draw on, and then cut out and join together. You can use any card you can cut into, for example packaging such as cereal boxes will work well, although it will look best if you can paint over any writing or pictures on the box.
