Maths

We are continuing our work on 2D shape. Read the information which will remind you of some facts about shapes and introduce the new words – vertex, vertices and quadrilateral. Then work your way through the 2D shape questions on the second document. The questions expect you to discuss your answers, and the reasons for your answers with an adult, and there are some example questions which your adult can ask you as part of your discussion.

English

Read or listen to **The Sound Collector – By Roger McGough** again (from Monday's work). We are going to use the pattern in The Sound Collector to write our own poems based on the sounds you can hear around your home and garden. Your poem **does not** have to rhyme. Read the poem writing document, and then go listening for sounds to put in your poem.
