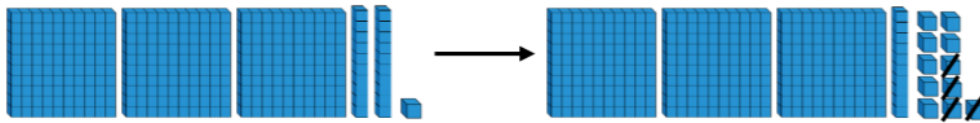

Maths

This time we're going to revisit subtracting one digit numbers to three digit numbers, crossing the tens boundary. That means we have to exchange. Try these Fluency questions for today.

Fluency

 Teddy uses Base 10 to calculate $321 - 4$



Use this method to calculate:

$$322 - 4 = 318$$

$$322 - 7 = 315$$


$$435 - 7 = 428$$

$$132 - 8 = 324$$

$$123 - 8 = 115$$

$$123 - 5 = 118$$

$$672 - 7 = 665$$

 Red team have 672 points.
Blue team have 7 fewer points than red team.
How many points do blue team have?

Blue team have 665 points
