




## Year Three 1/5/20

## Foundation Subject – PSHE (Happy Schools)

In Happy Schools we are going to look at coping and how we can cope in school or home when things might get difficult. This week I'd like you to think about how we cope when things get tough (like now!). We're going to think about mantras. A mantra is a positive saying that we repeat to ourselves either out loud or in our head to help us to focus and remember that everything is going to be alright.

Use the internet to research some famous positive sayings/quotes/mantras. We've looked at a few of these before in assemblies. See if you can find any mantras from famous people. Which ones are your favourite? Why? Now write your own. Think about a positive mantra that will help you or your family get through this strange time until we get back to normal. If you can, you could put your mantra on a poster and make it colourful and beautiful. Maybe you could put it up somewhere in your house where everyone can see it, or maybe you could make two copies of it and put one in your window for other people to see while they're out on a walk- you could make a positive difference to someone's day! ## Foundation Subject – Computing
