Parts of Plants




Look at this plant.

leaves




seed

Attracts insects and birds.

Catches sunlight to make energy. Takes in water and nutrients from the soil.

Holds the plant up.

Grow into new plants when they fall into the soil.

Making a Plant Picture




We are going to make plant pictures!

You will need:

- green straws
- sunflower seeds
- real leaves
- brown wool
- cup cake cases
- glue
- blue card
- brown card













Plant Pictures






Attach the flap of brown card by sticking the small part of the flap to the back of the blue card at the bottom.

What do you think this will be?



Stick the green straw just above the brown flap.


What part of the plant is this?



Stick the leaves to the blue card at the sides of the green straw.

Plant Pictures






Stick the cupcake case at the top of the straw. If you like, you can cut into the cupcake case first to make petal shapes.



Stick some seeds in the middle of the cupcake case.



Stick some pieces of brown wool to the bottom of the straw.

Spread them out under the flap.
