Rule 1: When a word ends in a 'y', change to 'i' before the suffix -ation is added.Rule 2: The silent 'e' at the end of a root word is dropped before adding -ation.Rule 3: If the root word ends in 'ate', drop the 'ate' when -ation is added.

<b>c)</b> to educate	education
<b>d)</b> to inform	information
