UK has a temperate climate – cold winters and mild summers Average maximum temperature is in July at 20.4 Degrees Celsius Average lowest temperature is in February at 0.9 Degree Celsius 2019 Average annual temperature is 9.4 Degrees Celsius 2019 total rainfall was 1240mm of rain 2019 total hours of sunshine was 1455hrs	Mediterranean climate is dry, hot summers and mild winters. Summer months average around 30-35 Degrees Celsius Winter temperatures are usually around 10 Degrees Celsius Mediterranean climate is a mostly dry climate. Almost no rain falls during the summer, so most of the rain falls during the cooler winter. Mediterranean climates receive around 500 mm of annual (yearly) rainfall.
Are there any similarities? – summers are hotter than falls in winter (but not always in UK).	You might find that you have slightly different numbers. This depends on the date and source of data.
