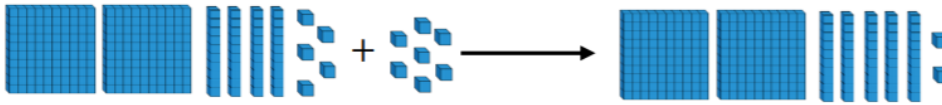
### Year Three answers 11/5/20

#### Maths

This time we're going to revisit adding one digit numbers to three digit numbers, crossing the tens boundary. That means we have to exchange. Try these Fluency questions for today.

Fluency

 We can use Base 10 to solve  $245 + 7$



Use this method to calculate:

$$357 + 8 = 365$$

$$286 + 5 = 291$$

$$419 + 1 = 420$$

$$564 + 8 = 572$$

$$716 + 9 = 725$$

$$327 + 5 = 332$$

$$178 + 9 = 187$$

$$826 + 7 = 833$$

$$359 + 8 = 367$$
