What day of the week is it today? Sing our 'Days of the week song'

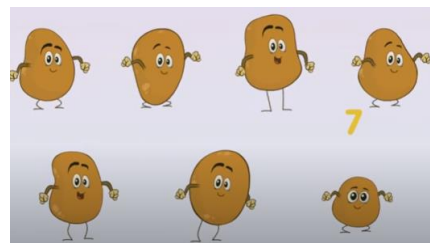
What is the weather like today? Can you draw a picture to match this?

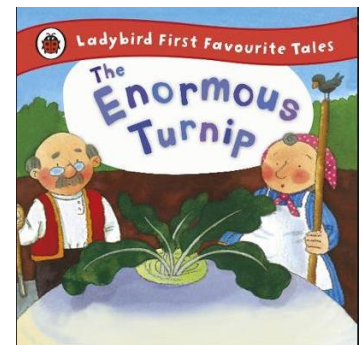
Storytime
