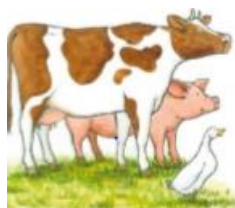
Our very own Mrs Sellers is back again as it's Groovy Moovy Monday!

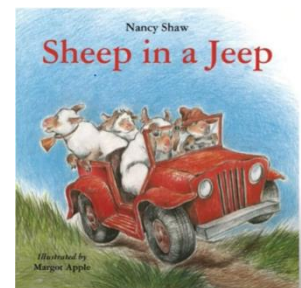
If you have some wool try making something with it!
