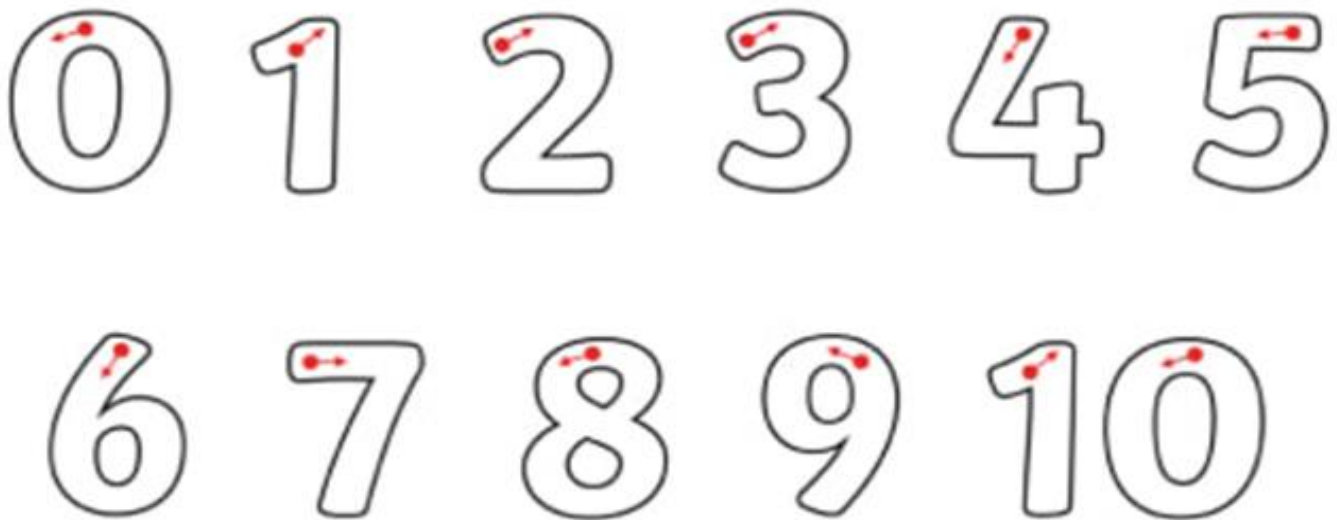
Five Little Chicks:

Using fingers to match the chicks in our song, use the link below to join in to this counting song!

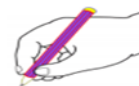

Choose a small number e.g. 2 and ask how many more do you need to make 3?
So 2 and 1 makes 3 etc

Maths

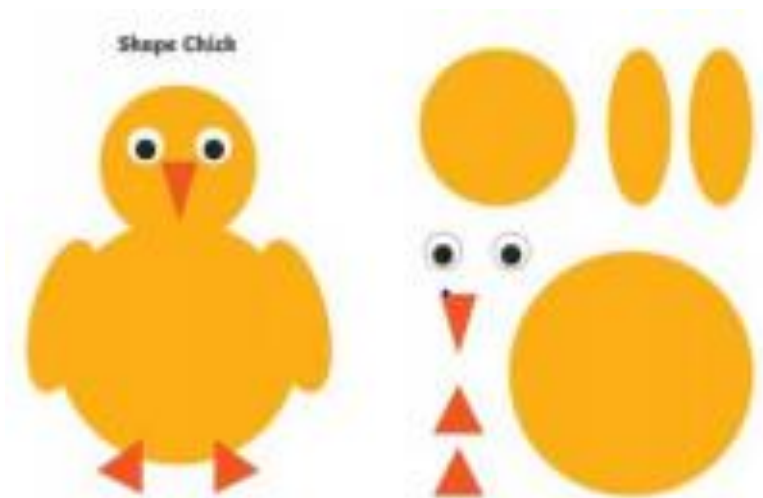
2D Shape Chick:

Can they identify each 2D shape? (Circle, oval, triangle)

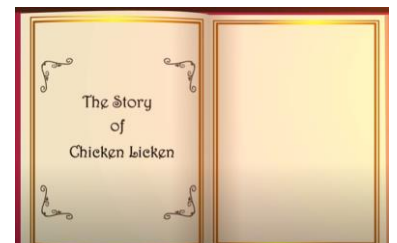
