## Maths

We are continuing with subtraction today and using the written method. Remember you can also draw counters in a place value chart if that helps. If you are still finding column subtraction difficult then you may prefer to just make your own subtractions up using 3 or 4 digit numbers to practise the method - just remember to put the largest number first!

Reasoning Mastery


Tommy is correct.
Amir is incorrect because he did not exchange, he just found the difference between the numbers in the columns instead.

There were 2,114 visitors to the museum on Saturday. 650 more people visited the museum on Saturday than on Sunday.


First you need to find the number of visitors on Sunday which is
$2,114-650=$ 1,464

Then you need to add Saturday's visitors to that number to solve the problem. $1,464+2,114=$ 3,578
