English

We're going to look at spelling for our English lessons this week.

The first spelling rule we're going to look at is using the letters 'ou' to make the 'u' sound. These letters are always in the middle of the word, but they don't always make the 'u' sound. For example, the 'ou' in 'trouble' make an 'u' sound, but the 'ou' in 'cloud' makes an 'ow' sound. We're only going to look at words that include 'ou' making the 'u' sound.

There are two parts to today's task.

- 1. Write down as many words as you can that use 'ou' to make the 'u' sound. One example of this would be 'tough'.
- 2. Watch the video Mrs Sands has put on for you. See if you can rearrange the letters of the anagrams she gives you to find some words that use this spelling rule.
