If we followed the rule for each of the verbs and turned them into nouns, the words would look like this:
Found + ation $=$ foundation (we don't need to change the spelling of the verb)
Magic + ation = magication. This isn't a real word!
Inform + ation = information (we don't need to change the spelling of the verb)
Admire - - - admir + ation = admiration (the verb ends in e so we need to remove it first)
Repeat + ation = repeatation. This isn't a real word!
Prepare -- - prepar + ation = preparation (the verb ends in e so we need to remove it first)
Adore - - - ador + ation = adoration (the verb ends in e so we need to remove it first)
Pass + ation = passation. This isn't a real word!

Did you get them right? Use a dictionary to look up the definitions for any words you are unfamiliar with. I think maybe adoration might be a new word for some of us.
