Maths

This work looks at measuring mass using the standard measurements of grams and kilograms. You could use kitchen scales at home to investigate different objects and practise using the correct language of mass, grams and kilograms, but you don't need any special weights like those shown in the pictures. There are some question sheets that will need you to make some estimations (best guesses) about mass, and practise counting in sets of 100 grams. If you fancy a challenge you could try the practical investigation at the end of the questions.

English

Draw Puss from the Puss-in-Boots story we read this week. Write a character description to describe his looks, personality, likes etc. Try to include as much detail as possible in your writing, and use examples from the story to explain why you think something (For example – He is a very clever cat because..................) I have uploaded a target sheet to remind you of the features your writing should include. You'll get bonus points for including some shortened (contraction) words in your work!

Topic work – Seaside Features

Look through the information sheets. They have lots of photos from different seaside towns. What seaside features can you see?
