Maths

For the next few lessons we are looking at telling the time. Today's work is on www.mymaths.co.uk. The lesson will explain how to tell the time and give you some activities to complete. You could also make a clock which would be useful to practise making different times. I have included a clock face activity sheet if you would like to print it out, or you could use a paper plate, or card circle to make your own clock. You could attach the clock hands with a split pin or blu-tack.

English

This sheet has different activities for practising correct use of spelling, punctuation and grammar. Just write your answers on paper, and then check the answer sheet on Friday.

I have also included a list of spellings that you could practise this week. They are all homophones. Can you write each word in a sentence correctly? You can also use this opportunity to practise your neat, cursive handwriting.

Topic work – Science

Can you draw some minibeasts in the kind of microhabitat where they would live? I have included a habitat picture that you could print out or draw your own, then add your own minibeasts. Can you write some labels to explain why they live in that place? For example: Woodlice live under logs because they like dark, damp places and they eat rotting wood.
