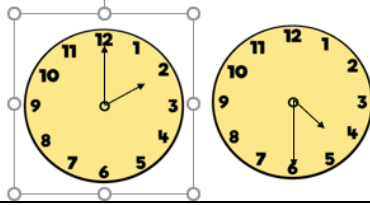
Maths - Time
