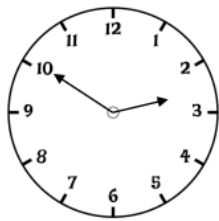

The clock shows ten minutes to 3

Dora

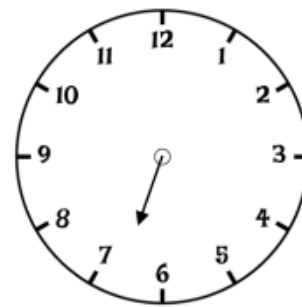
The hour hand is not quite pointing to the 3, so it must be ten to 2



Amir

Who do you agree with?
Explain your thinking.

Q2



This clock has lost its minute hand.

What time could it be?
Justify your answer.

Answers -

Q1 - Dora is correct because it is not 3 o'clock yet, the hour hand will not be exactly on the 3

Q2 - The time is around half past six. It could also be between twenty five to and quarter to seven.
