



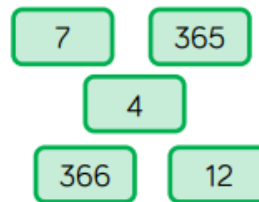

## Maths – Time

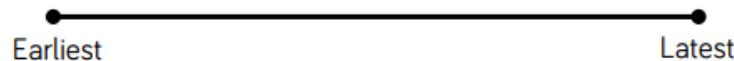
