Task 2

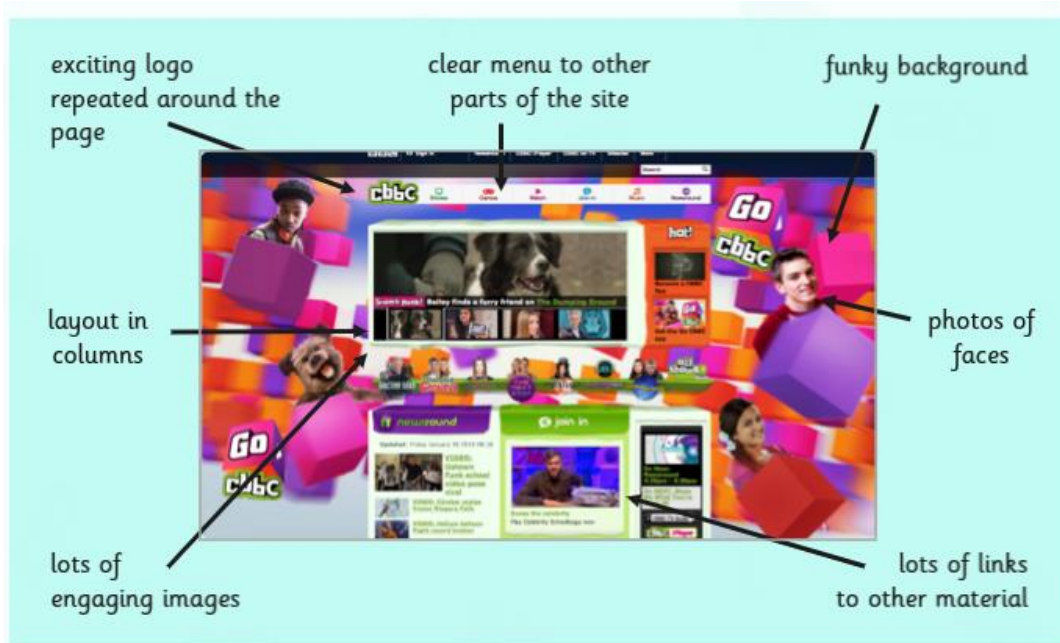
