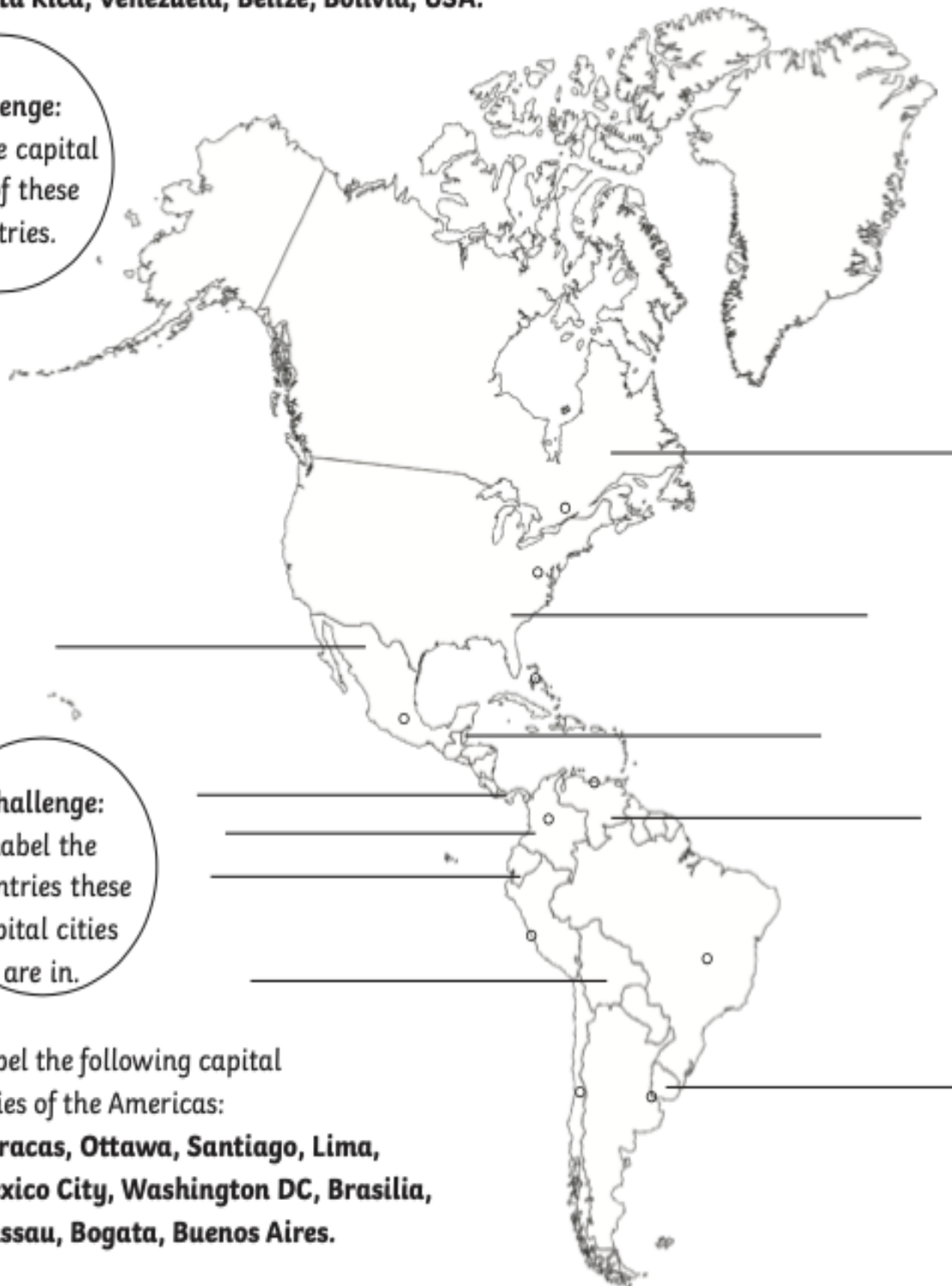
### **Foundation Subject – Geography**
