Collage is an art technique that involves cutting and gluing different materials together to make a picture.

This picture has been made using different types of paper and string.





Collages can be made using a range of materials. Materials can be cut and assembled onto paper to make a larger picture. You could use any of these materials below.

paper






Here are some steps showing how to make a garden scene with collage.




Start by drawing a rough outline of your scene.



Cut some leaves and glue them in a tree shape.



Paint glue onto your page and stick leaves down to make grass.



Use some beads and sequins to make the flowers.




Apply plenty of glue and stick conker shells down to make rocks.



Add some extra leaves to the tree for extra detail.





When all the excess glue is dry you may like to paint the sky blue and add detail to the birds in the distance.
