

Maths

Jack wants to tell the time, but the hour hand has fallen off the clock.





I don't agree with Jack because there are 26 different possible times it could be. The time could be ten o clock, ten to one, ten to two, ten to three, ten to four, ten to five, ten to six, ten to seven, ten to eight, ten to nine, ten to ten, ten to eleven or ten to twelve. These times happen twice a day, am and pm. The minute hand and the hour hand of a clock are both pointing to an even number.

It is before midday. What times could it be?

Give three possible answers.

The time could be 2 o clock, 4 o clock, 6 o clock, 8 o clock, 10 o clock or 12 o clock. It could also be ten past, twenty past, or half past 2, 4, 6, 8 or 10, or twenty to or ten to 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 or 12. That took a lot of working out!
