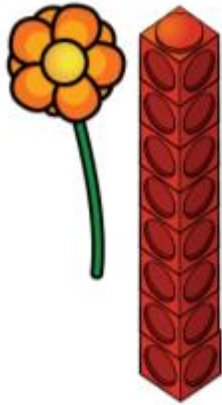
## Maths
