What is the weather like today? Can you draw a picture to match this?


Remember to always write your name on your work.

- Now challenge your child to sound one of the pictures out for you to guess.














Maths:

Have a try at drawing your own triangle, square, rectangle, circle and oval using chalks on the pavement or path.

Remember curved edges or straight sides.

Can you draw a combination of shapes to make a house with a roof and windows & doors or a flower with a circle centre and oval petals?
