Listen to the letter 'S' song from the link below then ask your child to look at the shape of the letter and can they then draw it with their finger:

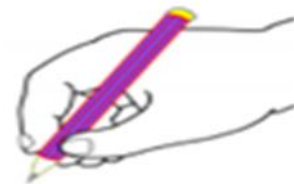

Practise writing this letter correctly using your 'Froggy Fingers' and starting at the green dot as shown.

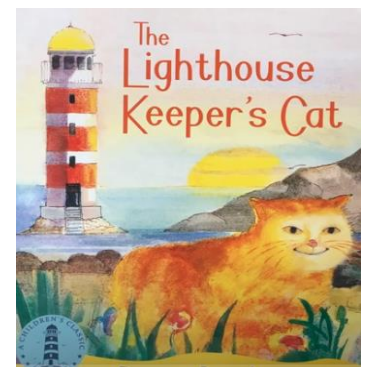


Storytime:
