Art: **Ice Creams**

- Use pastel coloured paint to make the ice cream on top. Leave to dry.
- Decorate the ice cream with a pom pom cherry or 'Hundreds & Thousands' sprinkles or sequins for fruit etc.
- Cut out using 'careful cutting' then make a cross pattern on the cone to finish.

Listen to the letter 'a' song from the link below then ask your child to practise this sound themselves. Look at the shape of the letter and can they then draw it with their finger.



Practise writing this letter correctly using your 'Froggy Fingers' and starting at the green dot as shown.






Storytime:
