





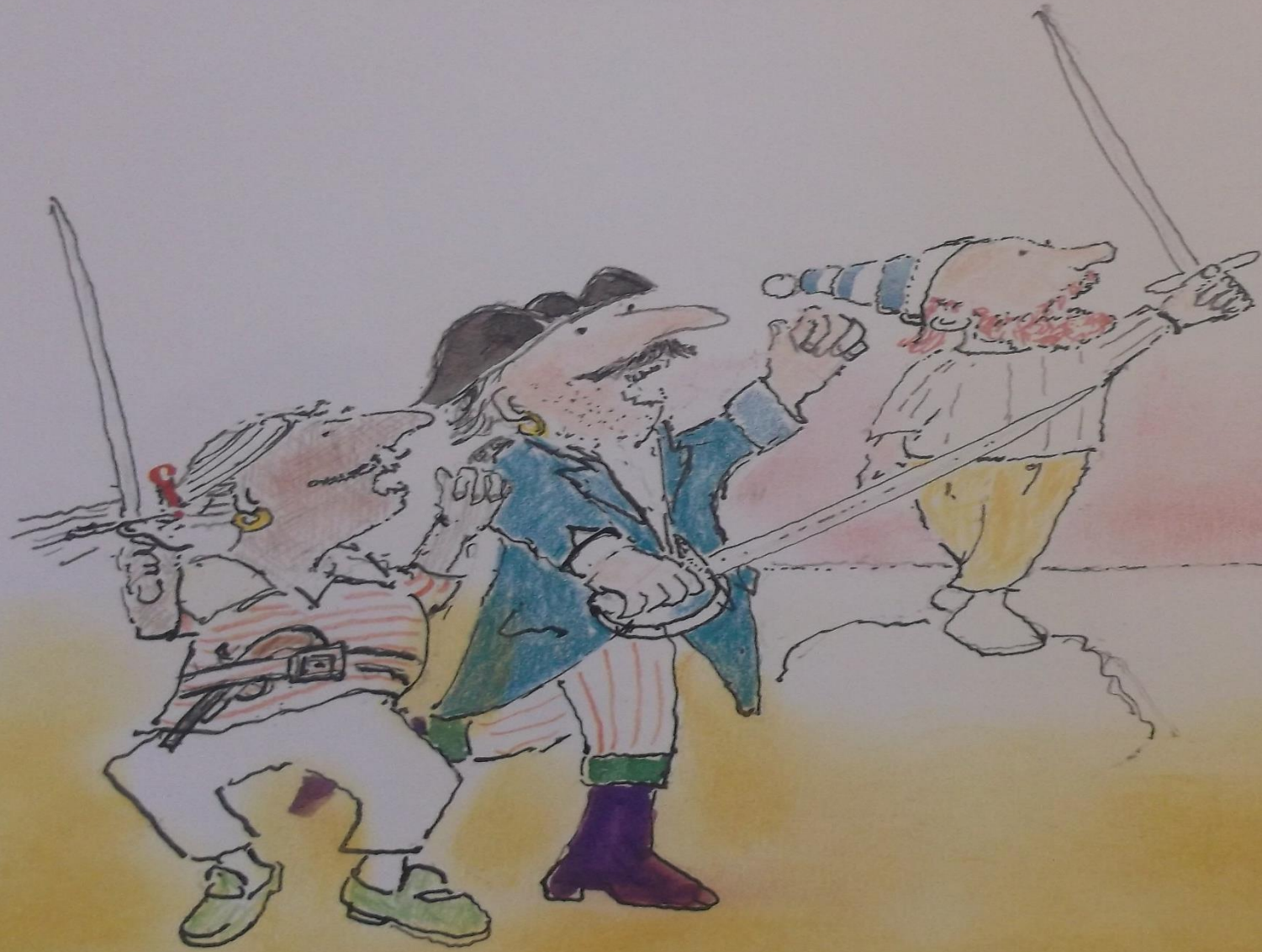
On one of his journeys, Georgie found

They chased Georgie down the beach . . .

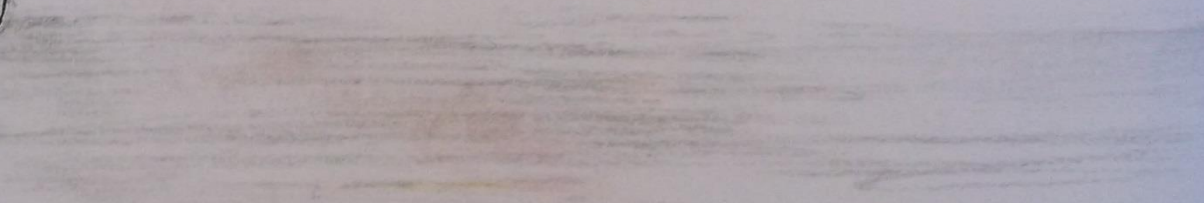






and he only just managed to escape.

which is why his bed was sometimes wet in the mornings.



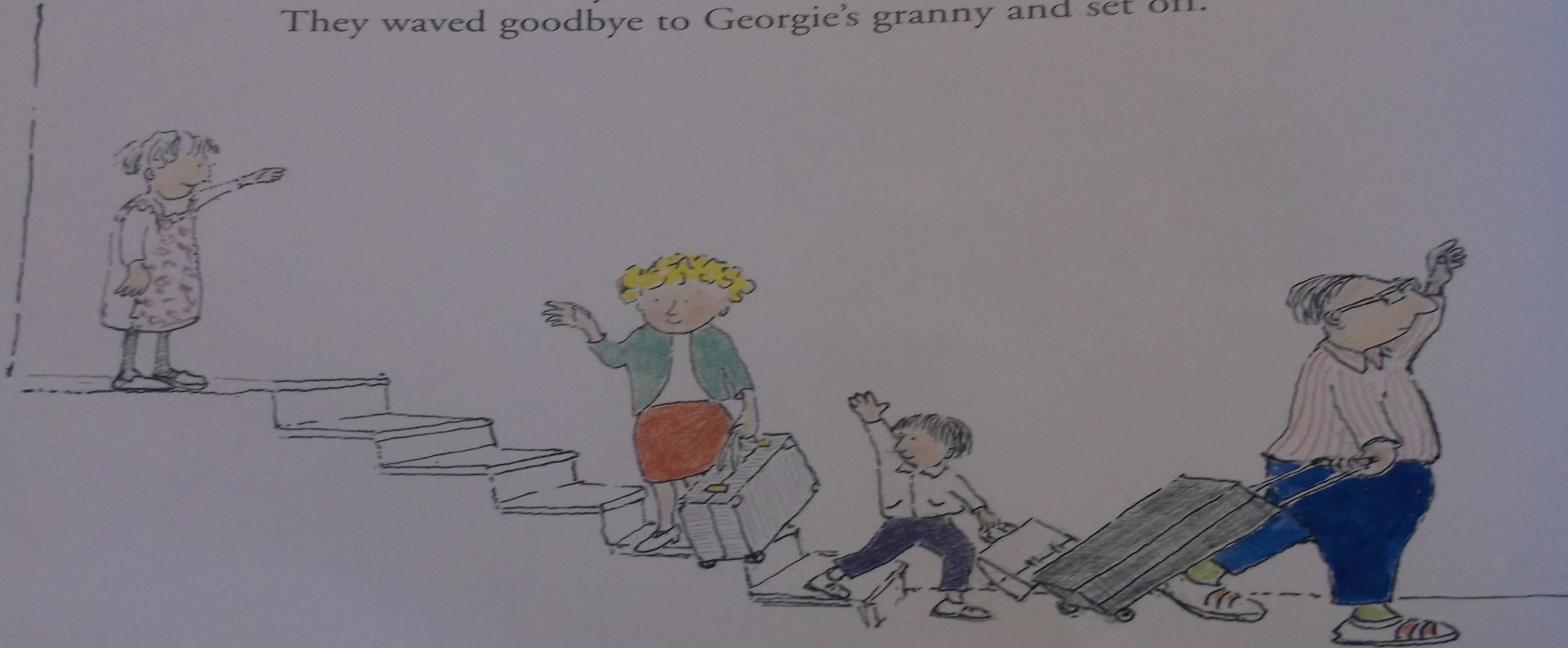




Another night, Georgie gave a lift to some geese that were very tired because they had flown a long way. Then he had a race with some witches.

and they all came home.





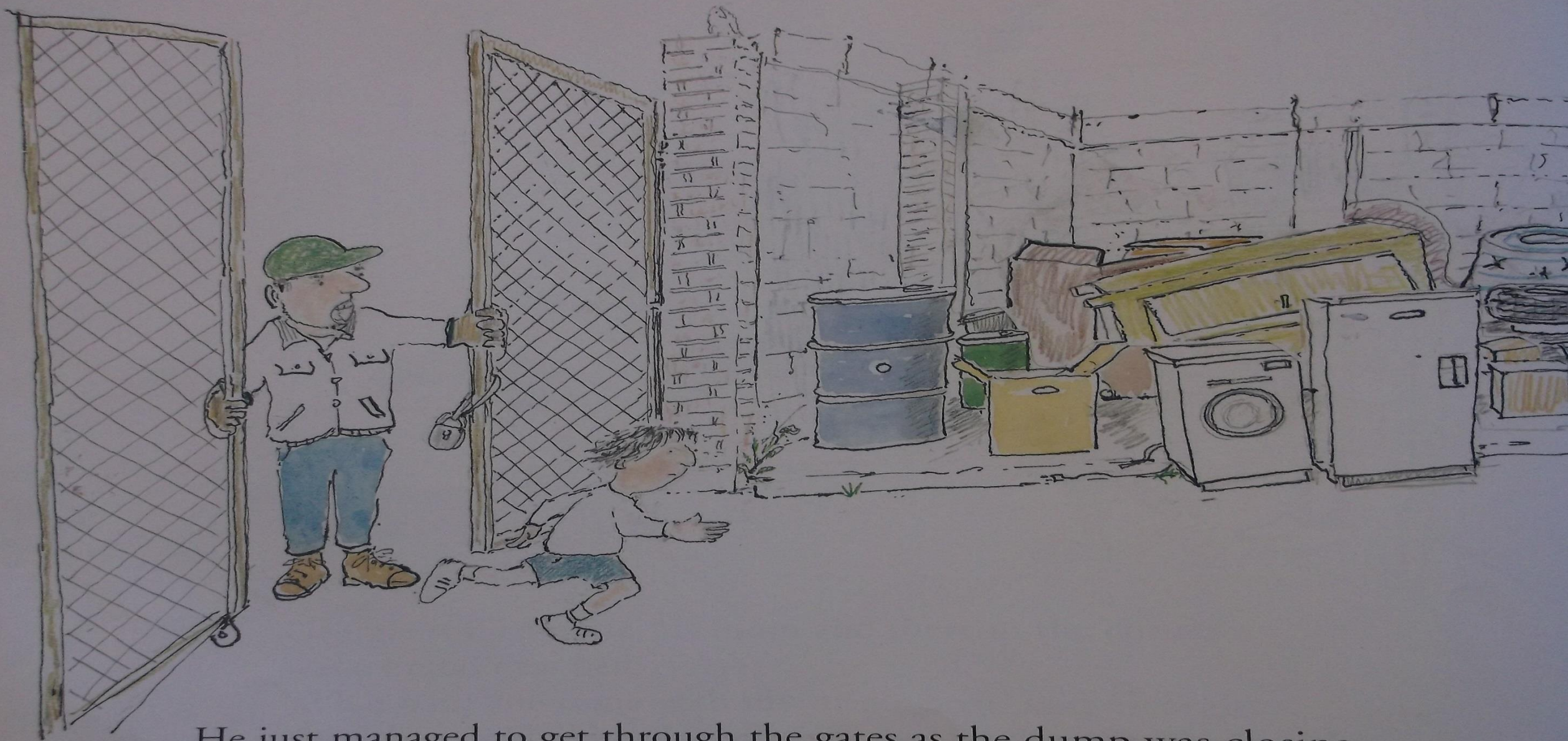
‘There is a lovely present for you, Georgie.
It’s in your room,’ said his granny.



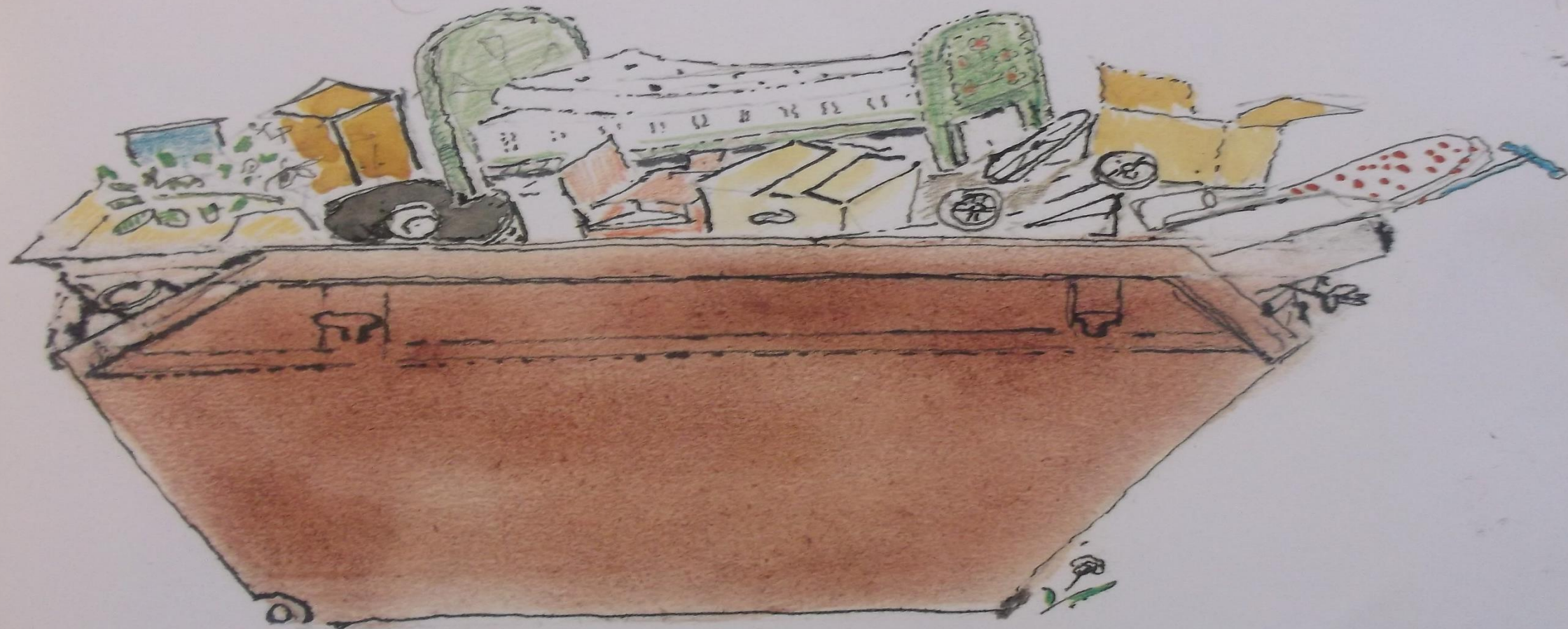
Georgie rushed up to his room and there in the corner was a brand new bed.

'Oh, that nasty old bed went down to the dump today,' said Granny.



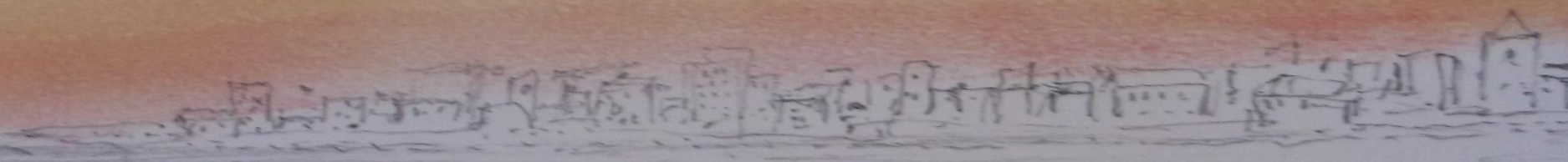
Georgie raced out of the house, down the steps
