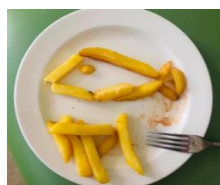
Fishes and Wishes

Don't forget to take a photo and tell Mrs Caden & Mrs Smith too.



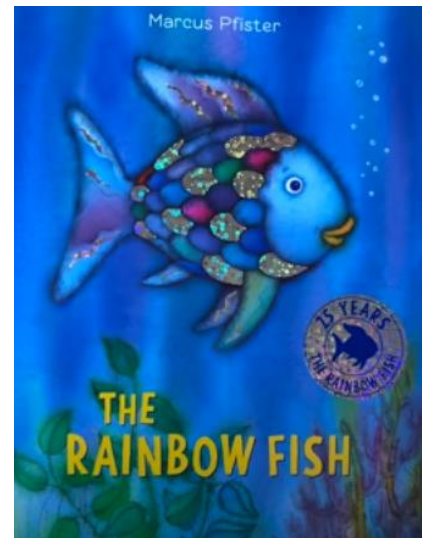
Storytime:
