On Monday we read about Prometheus who stole fire from the gods and gave it to mankind. If you remember, he was punished by being chained to a rock and having a vulture peck out his liver each day and having a new liver grow back every night. Zeus was furious that Prometheus had given mankind the power of fire and his punishment wasn't over. He also wanted to punish the humans.

Today I'm going to upload two versions of the same story. The story itself is called 'Pandora's Box'. One version is a comic strip and continues on from Monday's story. The other is a written story. Your job today is to compare the two.

You need to read both stories (I'll read them to you too) and make a list of what is the same in both stories and what is different. Once you've done this, I'd also like you to decide which version of the story you prefer and why.

Foundation Subject – Science

This half term we're going to continue our work on plants. I'd like you to look at the resource I've uploaded for you so you can see the parts of a flower and understand what each part is used for. Your job this week is to dissect (carefully take apart) a flower and see if you can see all of the different parts. Think about the flower you choose to use. Flowers like daisies aren't good for this activity because they're quite small and some of the parts aren't easy to see. Choose a larger flower that looks similar to the one on the sheet. Lastly, remember what I've always said about picking wild flowers. We shouldn't really do it but one for this occasion is okay. If you have any flowers in your garden or a bunch of flowers in a vase in your house, (with permission) these are perfect.
