
### Year Three answers 17/6/20

#### Maths

Instead of '15 minutes past', we could say 'quarter past' because the big hand has travelled around a quarter of the clock.

Instead of '30 minutes past', we could say 'half past' because the big hand has travelled around half of the clock.

Label the clock to show what time would be shown if the minute hand was pointing to each interval.



Instead of '15 minutes to', we could say 'quarter to' because the big hand only has to travel another quarter of the clock to reach the 12.

#### **English**

So you should have chosen to describe either the Nemean lion, the Lernaean hydra, the Ceryneian hind, the Erymanthian boar, the horses in the Augean stables, the Stymphalian birds or the Cretan bull.
