Maths

I hope you're learning the months and practising telling the time! Here are some Reasoning and Mastery questions about the months and their days.

Reasoning

4 children describe their birthdays.

Mo: My birthday is the first day of the second month.

Teddy: I was born on the 15th of June.

Eva: I was born on the last day of the year!

Dora: I was born two days before Mo.

Dora - 30th Jan  
Mo - 1st Feb  
Teddy - 15th June  
Eva - 31st Dec

Can you work out their birthdays and order them from earliest to latest in the year?

Mastery

Whitney asks Rosie and Jack a question.

Whitney: Some months have 31 days, some months have 30 days. How many months have 28 days?

Rosie: Only February has 28 days.

Jack: Every month has 28 days.

They are correct for different reasons. Rosie is correct because only February has exactly 28 days, but Jack is correct because every month has at least 28 days.

Who do you agree with? Explain your thinking.

Now that you know the features of a Greek myth, I'd like you to read another one and see if you can find all of the features. We need to read quite a few Greek myths so that we become familiar with them because they are a completely different genre of story. This time I'd like you to read the myth 'Bellerophon and Pegasus'. I've also uploaded a video of me reading it so that you can hear what the names sound like. What you need to do is find where each of the features of Greek myths is included in the story.

- Who is the hero? Bellerophon
-What is the monster? The Chimera
-What is the test? Bellerophon has two- to catch Pegasus and kill the chimera
-Who helps the hero? The magician
-Is there a king or queen? Yes, the king sends Bellerophon on his quest
-Where does the hero journey to on his quest? To the hills to find Pegasus and then to the chimera's lair
