### Maths

You can make **6** towers of 5

**6** towers of 5 is the same as 30

30 is the same as **6** towers of 5

$$40 \div 5 = 8$$

Each child gets 8 pencils

We need four 5p coins to make the same amount of money.

4 lots of 5p = 20 one pence coins

4 lots of 5p = 20p

$$20p = 4 \times 5p$$

$$20p \div 5 = 4p$$

A jar contains 5 party bags.



Ron has 75 sweets.

How many party bags will he need?

How many jars will he need?
