You can make 6 towers of 5 6 towers of 5 is the same as 30 30 is the same as 6 towers of 5

 $40 \div 5 = 8$ 

Each child gets 8 pencils

We need four 5p coins to make the same amount of money.

4 lots of 5p = 20 one pence coins

4 lots of 5p = 20p

20p = 4x5p

 $20p \div 5 = 4p$
